#### **HISTORICAL NOTE:**

Medical Strollers of New York City was founded in the early 1920s. Members are outstanding physicians working in New York City. Membership is limit to one hundred. The club is purely social and for disseminating non-medical knowledge. Any topic other than medicine can be discussed at the regular meetings held at the Union Club. The regular meetings feature a lecture with a black tie dinner.

#### NOTE OF PROVENANCE:

The provenance is unknown.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENTS NOTE:

The records are divided into three series: Minutes, 1929-1962, Correspondence, 1942-1966 and Miscellaneous, 1932-1964.

### Minutes, 1929-1962

The minutes are arranged chronologically. They include the by-laws and annual reports.

### Correspondence, 1942-1966

The correspondence file, which deals mostly with membership issues, is arranged alphabetically by the doctors' surnames. All correspondence regarding a specific doctor is filed together under his name. For example, letters nominating a specific doctor for membership is file under that doctor's name. There are two folders on correspondence regarding speeches. One file contains letters regarding a controversy over allowing Dr. Joseph Hinsey membership to the club. Dr. Joseph Hinsey who was the Dean of the Cornell University Medical College and the Director of the New York Hospital-Cornell Medical Center did not have a MD degree causing some members to oppose his membership to the club.

#### Miscellaneous, 1927-1964

This series is arranged alphabetically by subject. It includes financial statements, 1932-1964, membership cards and lists and yearbooks, 1927-1958.
