ABSTRACT:

The New York Hospital was chartered in 1771 by King George III of England and first opened to patients in 1791 in New York, NY. The New York Hospital Medical Records include bound casebooks and loose folders containing medical records for patients treated at the New York Hospital between 1808 and 1932.

CREATOR:

PROVENANCE:

The bound casebooks and loose patient medical records were managed by the Record Department of New York Hospital prior to being transferred to the Medical Center Archives sometime after its creation in 1972.

ADMINISTRATIVE/BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:

New York Hospital was chartered in 1771 by King George III of England. The hospital was erected along the west side of Broadway in Lower Manhattan, New York. A fire and the Revolutionary War delayed the opening of New York Hospital until 1791. From its founding the hospital received both pay patients and charity patients. Payment was for the patient's cost of boarding at the hospital, though the medical treatment was free. Anyone was eligible to be admitted as a charity patient at the Visiting Committee's discretion.

New York Hospital had medical and surgical divisions. The hospital clinical staff involved in creating patient medical records for the divisions included an attending physician and surgeon, house physicians and surgeons, and senior and junior assistants, sometimes referred to as senior and junior walkers, which was a reference to them accompanying the house physicians and surgeons during their daily patient visits.

The earliest mention of medical record keeping appears in the 1811 bylaws of New York Hospital, which noted that it was the responsibility of the senior assistants, under the direction of the house physicians and surgeons, to keep a register of all cases. The bylaws specified the

information to be entered, which included the name, age, and occupation of each patient, the probable cause and history of disease, the remedies used before and after admission, the name of the attending physician or surgeon, their daily reports on the case, the termination of the disease due to recovery, relief, or death, and other circumstances that provide additional details on the nature of the disease and record of the operation (in the case of the surgical divisions.)

Until 1897, the attending physician or surgeon identified the cases they thought were worthy of preservation, and those patient medical records were saved and bound together in a casebook. With the introduction of admission and history numbers in January 1898, the hospital began keeping all patient medical records, foregoing the earlier selection process. The casebooks containing bound patient medical records were submitted monthly to the Visiting Committee for review and then secured in the hospital's library. The safekeeping of the casebooks later fell under the purview of the hospital's superintendent after the library closed in 1898.

Requirements for accessing patient medical records became more stringent over time. In the early 1800s they were available to friends of the patients in addition to the Board of Governors, physicians, surgeons, and students attending the hospital. However, by the turn of the 20th century, with the exception of the Board of Governors, physicians, and surgeons, permission for accessing the patient medical records required a written request to the Visiting Committee or the superintendent. The Executive Committee rules in 1898 note that requests from attorneys or corporate representatives with ongoing lawsuits involving a former patient would not be allowed to access the patient medical records without explicit consent from the patient.

New York Hospital closed its original location in February 1870 and opened a second, larger location on March 17, 1877 between West 15th and 16th Streets near Fifth Avenue in New York, NY. In its new location, the New York Hospital again had both a Medical Division and Surgical Division. In the first year the building opened, the inpatient department had 165 beds and treated 1,493 patients and the outpatient department treated 1,694 patients. By 1931, New York Hospital admitted 6,482 patients a year, in addition to seeing 12,884 outpatients. The increase in patients in the second location of the New York Hospital was reflected by an increase in the volume of patient medical records generated during this time.

New York Hospital closed its doors on their West 15th Street location and opened their third location, a joint medical center with Cornell University Medical College, at 525 East 68th Street in September 1932. Although patient medical records are actively created in the third location of the New York Hospital, these records are not preserved in the Medical Center Archives.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

The New York Hospital Medical Records include bound casebooks and loose folders containing medical records for patients treated at the New York Hospital between 1808 and 1932.

While the hospital treated patients from its opening in 1791, the patient medical records represented in this collection only begin in 1808. Each volume contains varying levels of details depending on the record-keeping methods of the time, though usually document personal information, cause of illness, observation notes, treatment, and discharge or record of death of the patient.

This collection does not include patient medical records created after 1932, when the New York Hospital moved to its third location, a joint medical center with the Cornell University Medical College, on 525 East 68th Street.

Although the phrase "patient medical records" is used throughout this collection (including its title), this collection includes both surgical and medical records.

ARRANGEMENT:

This collection is arranged into two series, based on the different locations of the New York Hospital:

Series 1. New York Hospital Patient Medical Records, 1808-1870

Series 2. New York Hospital Patient Medical Records, 1877-1932

Although the bound casebooks and unbound patient medical records in this collection were not in order when they were transferred to the care of the Medical Center Archives, and an effort was

made by the Medical Center Archives staff during the processing of the collection to recreate the order used by the original records creators by using available information such as dates, history numbers, and volume numbers.

Series 1: New York Hospital Patient Medical Records, 1808-1870 117 volumes (25.4 linear feet)

Series 1. This series includes bound casebooks of select patient records of the medical and surgical activities at New York Hospital from 1808 through 1870, when the first hospital building closed its doors in preparation for a move to a new building.

The records were entirely handwritten, not yet utilizing printed templates that became standard practice in medical recordkeeping at the hospital starting in 1898 (see Series 2, Subseries 2B). The entries, listed chronologically by admission date, generally begin with a diagnosis as the heading, followed by a narrative about the patient, their condition, and details on the treatment or surgical procedures.

This series is arranged into two subseries for medical and surgical records.

Subseries 1A: Patient Medical Records, 1809-1870 44 volumes (9.75 linear feet)

This subseries includes bound casebooks of select patient records of the medical (non-surgical) activities of the New York Hospital from 1809 through 1870, when the first hospital building closed its doors in preparation for a move to a new building.

Medical treatment at the hospital required approval from the Visiting Committee, except in cases of emergency. Patients often needed to be recommended for admissions by a member of the Board of Governors or one of the physicians who examined the patient. The purpose and mission of the New York Hospital focused on the ability to cure patients of common diseases or accidents using medical treatment. Therefore, the hospital did not admit patients whose conditions were deemed incurable, since those patients were considered to be more appropriate for the almshouse. In addition, individuals with infective or contagious diseases, such as smallpox or measles, were not admitted, though they were sometimes treated in the outpatient unit and attended by the hospital's physicians.

Subseries 1B: Patient Surgical Records, 1808-1870 73 volumes (15.6 linear feet)

This subseries includes bound casebooks of select patient records from the surgical activities of the New York Hospital from 1808 through 1870, when the first hospital building closed its doors in preparation for a move to a new building.

All surgical procedures at the hospital required the approval from the Visiting Committee, except in cases of emergency. The surgical records typically covered a wide range of cases, including amputations, plastic surgery, operations for aneurysm, and the excision of tumors. There are also cases of tetanus, osteomyelitis, fractures and dislocations, and hernias that would not categorically fall under surgery in modern medicine, as well as cases that were difficult to classify at the time, such as a rattlesnake bite and a patient struck by lightning.

Series 2: New York Hospital Patient Medical Records, 1877-1932 1241 boxes (1333.1 linear feet) (inventory in progress)

Series 2. This series includes bound casebooks and unbound patient medical records in folders from 1877, when the New York Hospital opened a new location at West 15th Street in New York City until 1932, when the New York Hospital opened its third location, a joint medical center with the Cornell University Medical College, at 525 East 68th Street.

This series is arranged by medical record keeping practice into three subseries.

Subseries 2A: Bound Casebooks, 1877-1897 Estimated 110 boxes (146 linear feet)

This subseries includes bound casebooks of select New York Hospital patient medical records organized first by hospital division (either Medical, First Surgical, or Second Surgical), followed by volume number. The exception to the organizational method of this subseries are the casebooks with missing spines. The volumes without spines, which noted the specific division information and volume number, are itemized at the end of each divisional grouping in the inventory created by the Medical Center Archives.

The patient medical records within each bound casebook are generally written chronologically, though there are exceptions. The records were entirely handwritten, not yet utilizing printed templates that became standard practice starting 1898 (see Series 2, Subseries 2B). Some casebooks also include an index of patients listed alphabetically by last name or a list of diagnoses at the beginning of each volume.

Subseries 2B: Bound Casebooks, circa 1898-1923 Estimated 491 boxes (654.6 linear feet)

This subseries consists of casebooks of all New York Hospital patient medical records for multiple divisions at the hospital: Surgical (beginning on February 7, 1910), Medical (beginning on January 1, 1898), and Private Patients (beginning in September 1910).

The bound casebooks are organized first by division, followed by history number (sometimes referred to as an admission number.) This method of organizing case histories within each division continued until a new method of organizing cases by diagnosis was introduced to New York Hospital in 1914. All divisions adopted this new practice, except for the Private Patients Division, which continued to organize their patient medical records by history number through 1923.

The exception to the organizational method of this series are the volumes without clear division information, because the information was lost when the spine detached from the book due to the deterioration of these specific volumes over time. The volumes without

known divisions are itemized at the end of the inventory created by the Medical Center Archives.

The bound casebooks in this series include printed templates, which were introduced for medical record keeping in 1898. The printed templates identified data, history, and physical examination; medication, treatment and progress notes, and temperature; pulse and respiration data; and laboratory details. The printed templates were primarily filled in with handwriting, though some pages were typed.

Subseries 2C: Patient Medical Records Using Bellevue Hospital Nomenclature of Diseases and Conditions, 1914-1932 640 boxes (532.5 linear feet)

This subseries includes bound casebooks and loose folders of all New York Hospital patient medical records from the Medical (First and Second) Division, Surgical (First, Second, and Third) Division, Private Patients Division, and Urology Division (including the James Buchanan Brady Foundation for Urology.)

All patient medical records in this series are organized by the *Bellevue Hospital Nomenclature of Diseases and Conditions*, which was used by the New York Hospital beginning in 1914. Within each category of this system, the patient medical records were organized chronologically by diagnosis and division by the original record creators. The hospital implemented this new method of record keeping due to the challenges of collecting patient medical records of any single disease, illness, or injury for the purpose of scrutiny and study. Once enough patient medical records accumulated, they were bound together chronologically into casebooks by diagnosis and division. Volume numbers were assigned to the casebooks after they were bound.

The inventory created by the Medical Center Archives reflects the original organizational method, sorted first by the *Bellevue Hospital Nomenclature of Diseases and Conditions*, then by diagnosis, then by division, and finally by history/admission number. The loose folders in this series are assumed to be patient medical records which were organized similarly to the bound casebooks but were not yet bound; the unbound patient medical records are also included in the inventory.

The patient medical records in this series include printed templates, which were introduced for medical record keeping by the hospital in 1898. The templates were usually filled in with handwritten details, though some pages were typed. Some patient medical records include hand-drawn diagrams and photographs.
